NOTICE OF BOND ELECTION RESULTS
May 2, 2026

The voters of the Silverton Independent School District failed to approve the following proposition in the special election held on May 2, 2026 (the “Proposition”).

SILVERTON – PROPOSITION A
THIS IS A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

Shall the board of trustees of Silverton Independent School District be authorized to issue and sell bonds of the District in the principal amount of \$10,500,000 for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, renovating, improving and equipping school buildings of the District; and shall there be levied, assessed and collected annually ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in the District sufficient, without limit as to rate or amount, to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds as the same become due and to pay the costs of any credit agreements executed or authorized in anticipation of, in relation to or in connection with the bonds; said bonds to be issued in one or more series or issues, to mature serially or otherwise not more than 40 years from their date, and to bear interest at such rate or rates not to exceed the limit prescribed by law at the time of issuance, as the board of trustees in its discretion shall determine?
